1. In consideration of Sunshine Coast Fraser and Burnett selecting me in the team mentioned above, I agree that I will

PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT

- At all times comply with the reasonable and lawful directions and instructions of the Tournament Director, Sunshine Coast Staff, Tour Manager, Team Coach and Manager.
- (If under 18 years of age) not partake of alcohol at any time (including travelling to and from the event)
- Behave in a proper and orderly manner at all times
- Will not leave the accommodation unless directed by Coach, Manager or Staff of Sunshine Coast Fraser and Burnett
- Will not enter rooms of the opposite gender
- Be responsible for making good any damage I cause to property and that I may be suspended or removed from the team/tour and suspended from future competitions for a period of time
- Not supply alcohol (directly or otherwise) to a person under 18 years of age
- Not take and will not supply to any person illegal or prohibited drugs or substances. (I understand offenders will be handed over to Police)
- Abide by the law at all times
- Abide by Sunshine Coast Fraser and Burnett Policies, the event Conditions, this agreement and the policies of QTF/ TFA
- Comply with the Players Code Of Behaviour set below

PLAYERS CODE OF BEHAVIOUR

PARTICIPANTS OF SUNSHINE COAST FRASER AND BURNETT TOURNAMENTS AND ANY SUNSHINE COAST FRASER AND BURNETT TOUR MEMBER WILL ADHERE TO THE FOLLOWING VALUES AND CODE OF ETHICS.

Encourage honest and open competition
Respect individual differences in people
Support innovation and creativity
Share failures and celebrate success
Coaching will be conducted by SCFDBTA appointed officials and mentors, full cooperation from players and parents will be expected
Participate as members of their team to achieve the Team's goals and objectives
Not engage in discriminatory or abusive behaviour (especially when children are involved)
Respect the rights and dignity of other participants
Not bring the game of Touch in disrepute
Play by the Rules at all times
Play equally loyal to yourself and your team
Exhibit exemplary sportsmanship at all times
Enjoy the game by giving your best at all times
Co-operate with your Coach, Manager, Team mates and Officials at all times

2. FOR THE CONSIDERATION MENTIONED ABOVE

- a) I indemnify Sunshine Coast Fraser and Burnett, it's servants, coaches, managers, agents and employees (Sunshine Coast) from and against all claims, demands, actions, suits and proceedings and the cost and expenses of or arising from the same for the injury to or death of any person and damage to property caused by me or attributed to my act, acts, omission or negligence and
- b) I release and discharge Sunshine Coast Fraser and Burnett (as defined above) from any claims I have or may have against them (or any one or more of them) arising from or with respect to injury to me, my death and/or damage to my property arising from my membership of the team or Sunshine Coast Fraser and Burnett authorized activities
- c) I understand by signing this agreement I will be available to represent a Sunshine Coast Fraser and Burnett District Touch Association team which I am selected in. I will adhere to the selection policy, which states I will play my age group first and I may then be eligible to play in an older age group also.
- d) I am a financial Sunshine Coast Fraser & Burnett District Affiliate player who has met the Regional / event conditions of entry eligibility requirements for selection.

Expectations of Sunshine Coast Fraser and Burnett District Touch Association Parents

- reinforce the appropriate player behaviour
- Whilst at an event parents will refrain from yelling and shouting to players on the fields
- Under no circumstances will parents be standing in the sub boxes or at the end of the fields coaching players, the only coaching will be from the SCFBDTA team appointed officials
- Players will be in camp and therefore will be under care of SCFBDTA officials, parents will not be permitted to take players during the event
- We appreciate the parents cooperation in reinforcing the good behaviour expected from our region whilst representing.
